

RECREATIONAL FACILITIES GUIDELINES

All activities will be scheduled through the Church Office.

Regularly scheduled activities of the congregation take first priority.

Specially scheduled meetings of the congregation and its auxiliaries take second priority. Events must be scheduled at least one week in advance.

Specially scheduled activities of non-member organizations may be held provided the Intergenerational Committee has approved the activity AND a voting member (over 21) has volunteered to be responsible for insuring proper use.

Adult voting member (over 18) may schedule gym for recreational use at otherwise unscheduled times.

Children under 12 years of age must have adult supervision when using the gym. Person scheduling event is responsible.

Use of the kitchen must be scheduled, also.

Minors (under 18) are not to be left at/in the building even when waiting for a ride home.

When individuals are using the gym (as per item #4) the gym will be closed by 10:00 p.m.. except by special permission of the Intergenerational Committee.

Soft bottom, no mark, tennis shoes must be worn at all times when practicing or engaging in games. Cleats should not be worn in the building.

Skating will not be allowed.

The entire floor shall be swept thoroughly before and after each use, and all spills mopped dry.

All garbage shall be disposed of immediately.

Heating units and all lights should be turned off before leaving.

Individuals responsible for damage of property within the Center due to carelessness, neglect, or "horseplay" will be liable for damage.

For all teams other than Pisgah's, appropriate forms are to be signed by each player (or the player's parents if the player is a minor) to exempt Pisgah Lutheran Church from responsibility in case of an accident or injury.

Individual reservations will be limited to two (2) hours once a week unless special arrangements are made.
